

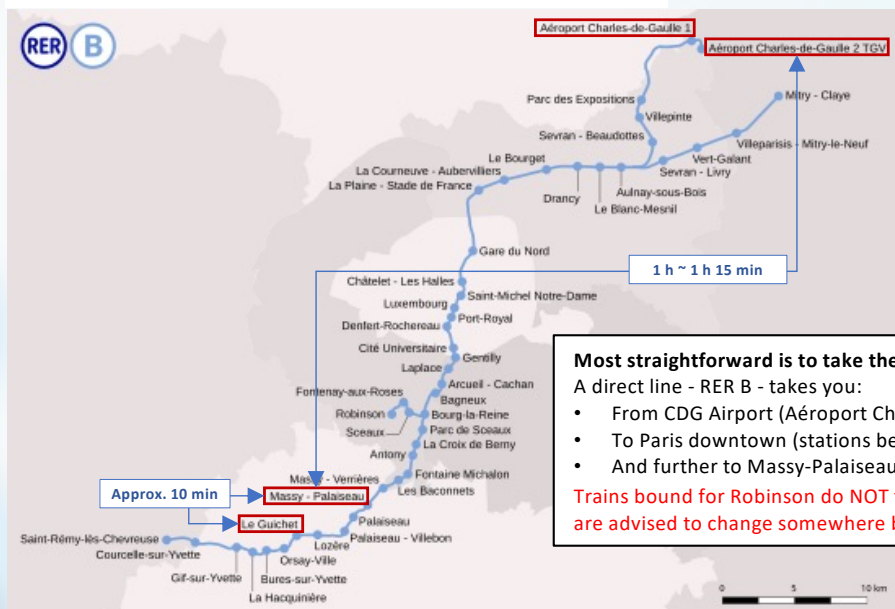

How to reach Paris-Saclay - Route

YOUR ROUTE BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION



Most straightforward is to take the train.

A direct line - RER B - takes you:

- From CDG Airport (Aéroport Charles-de-Gaulle)
- To Paris downtown (stations between Gare du Nord and Cité Universitaire)
- And further to Massy-Palaiseau and Le Guichet, gate stations to Paris-Saclay area

Trains bound for Robinson do NOT take you to Massy-Palaiseau nor Le Guichet, you are advised to change somewhere between Gare du Nord and Cité Universitaire.

Caution: maintenance work is often going on, especially nights after 22:00 and during week-ends

OPTION 1: Get off at MASSY-PALAISEAU

Information about Massy-Palaiseau station on page 2

Bus 91.06 takes you from Gare de Massy-Palaiseau (RER B station) to Paris-Saclay

To reach ENS Paris-Saclay:

- Take a bus for Christ de Saclay
- Get off at MOULON (< 1 min to ENS Paris-Saclay)

Total journey is **25-30 min**.

Buses bound for Gare du Guichet do NOT stop at MOULON. If you take these buses, get off at Université Paris-Saclay, and walk (5 min to ENS Paris-Saclay)

Recently, Corbeville bus stop has been replaced by Hôpital Paris-Saclay

OPTION 2: Get off at LE GUICHET

Information about Le Guichet station on page 3

Bus 9 takes you from Gare du Guichet (RER B station) to Paris-Saclay

To reach ENS Paris-Saclay:

- Take a bus for Christ de Saclay or Razel
- Get off at MOULON (< 1 min to ENS Paris-Saclay)

Total journey is approx. **10 min**.

French Grammar: "Le Guichet" is changed to ... "(Gare) du Guichet", or "(Stop) au Guichet"

How to reach Paris-Saclay - Station Maps (1)

MASSY-PALaiseAU STATION
to the Bus Terminal
“ATLANTIS SUD”

BUS 91.06

1. From RER B to Bus stop 91.06

- Climb the stairs on Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse side (front when arriving from Paris downtown and CDG Airport, no escalator nor elevator)
- Turn left and go to the end of the bridge over the train tracks
- Turn right at the ticket vending machines (see photo)
- Go down the stairs, bus stop 91.06 is right there



2. From ATLANTIS side to Bus stop 91.06

Hilton, Séjour & Affaires, Residhome, Mercure, TGV station

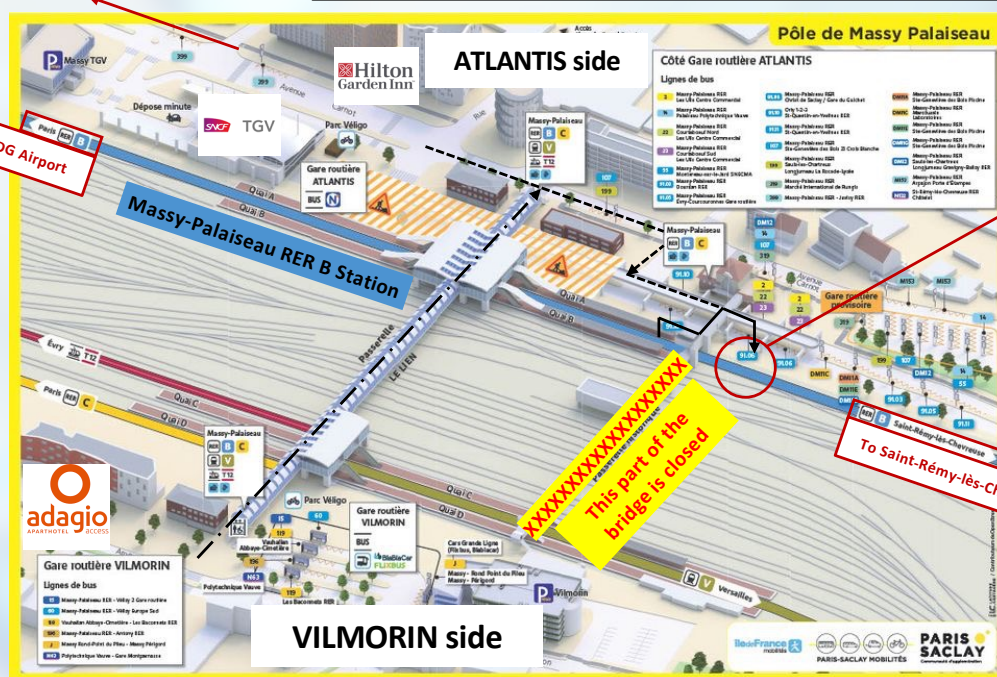
- Take Avenue Carnot direction SW (RER B train tracks on right side while walking)
- Follow signposts “Gare routière Atlantis Sud” (see photo)
- Turn right when the signpost indicates to do so (see map and photo)
- Climb the stairs (elevator available) and turn left
- Go down the escalator, bus stop 91.06 is right there



3. From VILMORIN side to Bus stop 91.06

- Take the main bridge crossing over the train tracks (including RER B tracks) to the other end, which is ATLANTIS side (see photo)
- Follow instructions 2.

The bridge on Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse side (close to the Bus Terminal “ATLANTIS SUD”) is closed



Most hotels are located on ATLANTIS side, one is on VILMORIN side and others are uphill (accessible by Bus 91.06)

- The main bridge (and exits) is in the middle of the train platform (stairs, elevator and escalator).
- Once on the bridge, turn left for ATLANTIS side, and right for VILMORIN side (when arriving from Paris downtown and CDG Airport).

TULIP INN and ALL SUITE: proceed to VILMORIN exit and walk (1 km, 15 min, uphill), or take Bus 91.06.

- When coming from Paris downtown and CDG Airport, take the underground passage at the front of the train, and turn right in the passage.
- Take Exit 5. "Rue du Guichet"
- Walk along the station car park, and cross the street "Rue du Guichet".
- Take the narrow path for pedestrian, cross "Rue Louise Weiss" and proceed to the bus stop.

Beside Bus 9, alternate possibilities are to take Bus 91.06 (Direction Gare de Massy-Palaiseau), 91.05 (Direction Polytechnique Vauve) or 91.08 (Direction Vélizy – Centre Commercial) and to get off at Université Paris-Saclay (5 min walk to ENS Paris-Saclay)



Tickets

Ticket types

Paper tickets are getting scarce, and the usual way is either to purchase a Navigo card (2 € for Navigo Easy, at ticket booths at stations, including Airports) or to download the Navigo app on your smartphone (free), and to charge it with the tickets you need. Only one person can use a card at the same time. In other words, even if 2 tickets are on the card, it cannot be used simultaneously by 2 persons.

Basically, there are only 3 types of single journey tickets:

- Paris Région – Aéroports (Airport ticket): 13 €
From any place to/from CDG or ORY Airport
- Métro-Train-RER: 2.50 €
Basically, for travelling with RER outside Paris downtown
Example: RER B Saint-Michel-Notre-Dame to/from Massy-Palaiseau
- Bus-Tram: 2.00 €
Example: Bus 91.06 Massy-Palaiseau to/from Moulon

There are also other tickets for commuters (Weekly Navigo, validity fixed from Monday to Sunday), for intensive visitors (Paris Région Pass, ...).
